Peter Carnesecchi (d. 1567), witness to the point of bloodshed in Italy

MARONITES:

Cyprian and Justina of Antioch (d. 304), martyrs

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

Cyprian of Antioch, ieromartire

Justina of Antioch, virgin and martyr

Theodore of Smolensk (d. 1299) and his sons David and Constantine, thaumaturges (Russian Church)

OLD CATHOLICS:

Leodegarius of Autun (d. ca. 680), bishop and martyr
