COPTS AND ETHIOPIANS (21 kiyahk/tahsas):

Barnabas (1st cent.), one of the 70 disciples (Coptic Church)

LUTHERANS:

Martin Schalling (d. 1608), poet in High Palatinate and at Nuremberg

MARONITES:

Anysia of Thessaloniki (3rd-4th cent.), martyr

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

Anysia, martyr

Habakkuk the Deacon and *Paisius the Igumen* (19th cent.), neomartyrs (Serbian Church)
