WESTERN CATHOLICS:

*Name of the blessed virgin Mary* (Ambrosian calendar)

COPTS AND ETHIOPIANS (2 tut/maskaram):

*Martyrdom of John the Baptist* (Coptic Church)

LUTHERANS:

*Matthäus Ilicky* (d. 1627), witness to the point of bloodshed in Bohemia

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

*End of the feast of the Nativity of the Mother of God*

*Autonomus* (d. 313), hieromartyr

*Removal of the relics of Alexander Nevskij* (1724)

*Founding of the relics of Daniel of Moscow* (1652; Russian Church)

*Gabriel* (16th-17th cent.), patriarch of the Serbs, martyr

*Synaxis of the holy hierarchs of the Serbian Church* (Serbian Church)
